SUBJECT:    PARENTS' STATEMENT OF SUPPORT OF MMA REGULATIONS

1.     I/we agree to support the Academy's faculty and staff in all matters pertaining to cadet discipline and the administration of MMA's military educational program.
  
2.     I/we will require my son/daughter to adhere to MMA's regulations and rules, and to conduct himself/herself as a gentleman/lady. In the event that my child's behavior results in the Academy assigning punishment(s), restriction to campus, tours, extra duty, community service or loss of rank or privileges, I will support the Academy's decisions.
  
3.     I/we agree that my failure to support and adhere to the Academy's rules and policies may lead to my cadet receiving appropriate punishment, suspension or dismissal.
  
4.     I/we agree to bring any concerns and disagreements directly to the attention of the appropriate Academy official and if not resolved satisfactorily to the attention of the President.
  
5. I/we understand and agree with the following Academy rules and procedures.
  - a.     A cadet's possession or use of illegal substances, prescription drugs, controlled substances or drug paraphernalia will lead to his/her dismissal.
  - b.     A cadet's possession or use of alcoholic beverages will lead to his/her dismissal.
  - c.     A cadet's trafficking of alcohol, illegal drugs, and prescription drugs or over the counter drugs will lead to dismissal.
  - d.     A cadet being disrespectful, disobedient or insolent to a member of MMA's staff or faculty may lead to his/her dismissal.
  - e.     A cadet's fighting or assault of another cadet may lead to his/her dismissal.
  - f.     A cadet's hazing of another cadet may lead to his/her dismissal.
  - g.     A cadet's assault or threat to assault a MMA staff or faculty member will lead to immediate dismissal.
  - h.     A cadet's inappropriate sexual conduct may lead to dismissal.
  - i.     A cadet's behavior that brings dishonor on the Academy or that undermines the discipline of the Corps of Cadets, the authority of the cadet Chain of Command, or the authority of the MMA staff and faculty may lead to dismissal.
  - j.     A cadet's violation of the honor code may lead to dismissal.
  
  - k.     A cadet's possession of any weapon, real or simulated, may lead to dismissal.
  - l.     A cadet's behavior or the possession of items or substances which endanger the health and/or safety of other cadets or members of the staff/faculty may lead to dismissal.

- m. A cadet's accrual of over 250 tours per year or over 125 tours in a semester will lead to dismissal.
- n. A cadet's violation of disciplinary probation will lead to dismissal.
- o. A cadet who is AWOL for more than 72 hours or who is AWOL more than three times in a year may be dismissed.
- p. A parent's failure to support the Academy's cadet regulations or policies may lead to the cadet's dismissal.
- q. A parent's failure to meet financial obligations will lead to cadets suspension or dismissal.
