**SUBJECT: MASSANUTTEN MILITARY ACADEMY'S DRUG AND ALCOHOL
POLICY**

1. General: It is the goal of Massanutten Military Academy to provide a drug free environment for our cadets, faculty and staff. This form must be signed as is with no modifications. Admission to MMA is predicated upon your consent to this policy. Parents with religious objections to drug and/or alcohol testing must submit a written request for an exception to this policy for approval by the President. This form may not be modified.

2. Application: This policy is applicable to all cadets enrolled at Massanutten Military Academy. The policy will be applied equally to all cadets, regardless of time enrolled, ethnic origin, sex, religion, or rank.

3. Specifics: All enrolled cadets will be governed by the following rules and policies.
 - a. Cadets will not possess or use alcohol or drugs while enrolled at Massanutten Military Academy on or off campus.
 - b. Possession or use of illegal substances or drugs, abuse of prescription and/or non prescription drugs or the possession of drug paraphernalia will lead to the cadet's dismissal from the Academy and an appropriate report being made to police.
 - c. The trafficking or sale of illegal drugs, prescriptions or non prescription drugs will lead to dismissal and pursuant to the Virginia State Law a report being issued to the police.
 - d. The Academy will conduct periodic searches of the barracks, to include cadet's personal property, bags, suitcases, wall and footlockers, etc. Police dogs, under the control of qualified handlers, will be employed for this purpose. Cadets returning from open weekends or furloughs may be searched prior to entering their barracks.
 - e. The Academy will conduct drug testing both on a random basis, and a directed basis. If a cadet is suspected of drug use or possession, or when deemed necessary by Academy officials, a cadet will be required to participate in a drug test. Each week the Commandant's Office may randomly select cadets to participate in a drug test. A cadet who refuses to participate in the random or directed drug test or who tampers with the test may be dismissed.

The results of the Academy's drug test(s) are final. The cadet's possession of or use of substances or actions that alter a urinalysis test's results may lead to dismissal.

4. By signing below, I/we (the cadet and parent/guardian) acknowledge reading, understanding and agreeing to adhere to and support the policy outlined above and agree that this policy is valid and remains in effect for the entire period that my son/daughter remains at the Academy.
